Congress of ISC is the supreme body of power of ISC.

Board of ISC is the executive body of and elected by the Congress of ISC, which carries out normal duty during the close of General

Assembly. It is held responsible to the Congress of ISC. Standing Committee is elected by and responsible to the Board, and exercises its functions and powers stipulated by the By-laws of ISC during the close of the Congress. It elects one Chair, several Vice-Chairs, one Secretary General and several Directors.

Secretariat is the administrative body of the Board, and sets up one Secretary General and three to four Vice Secretary Generals. Secretary General is in charge of Secretariat's normal duty: organizing and carrying out annual plan; putting into effect the decisions of Congress, the Board and the Standing Committee; coordinating internal works of each body of ISC; nominating Vice Secretary General and top officials of each body, branch, and other organizations, as well as submitting proposals to the Board and the Standing Committee for decisions; employing staff members and carrying out ISC's daily functions. Vice Secretary Generals assist the Secretary General in his/her work.
