
We thank Joanna Kulezsa, ALAC member, for the organization of the At-Large Policy Session:

This session looked into the progress and perspectives of the proposed UN cybercrime treaty and explores how it might impact ICANN's mission and trying answers to these questions: How does DNS Abuse fit in with existing cybercrime frameworks, both: national and international? 
