The applicant states: The primary purpose of the association is to provide and create space/forum for discussion for individuals who are active in Internet Governance and other ICANN-related matters, but who do not have a home in the current ICANN system. Our current leadership is currently ad interim, because there will be elections of the permanent leadership. The current interim leadership are actively involved in IG related issues since several years now.

Roberto Gaetano has been an active participant in the Internet and the ICANN policy making process since 1997. As a representative of ETSI(European Telecommunication Standards Institute), he played important roles in the formation of CORE (Coucil of Internet Registrars), the policy discussions around the U.S. Government's White Paper (International Forum on the White Paper), and the formation of ICANN's original Domain Name Supporting Organization (DNSO). He served as one of the first chairs of the DNSO General Assembly and has focused his efforts in recent years on bringing to life a constituency for individual users and registrants.

Veronica Cretu, has been active in the Internet Governance field since 2004 when she completed her pot-graduate studies in Diplomacy and IT, and joined immediately after DiploFoundation as a Program Tutor and Supervisor for the Internet Governance Capacity Building Program.
