

**All announcements sent to ALSes below on 17 May 2014 –
Decertification from ALAC and EURALO / KEPKA**

After long discussions at EURALO and ALAC, these ALSes (dead ducks) were finally contacted and informed about their forthcoming decertification. The information given was not mere random but based on EURALO's / my statistics on their particular non-performance over the last years.

Hello
(we do not even have a valid contact point for your ALS),

your organisation – KEPKA Greece – was certified (under No. 90) in February 2007 as an At-Large structure (ALS) at EURALO. EURALO was created by signing a MoU with ICANN in March 2007 and became operational soon afterwards. Since then we had subsequent General Assemblies from 2008 (3 face-to-face when all members were invited and 3 with remote participation).

Since your certification in early 2007 – over seven years now – your ALS NEVER responded to anything at EURALO. You never attended any GA and the two At-Large Summits (2009 and 2014) for which you were invited.

We can take these facts as a clear message of lack of interest or indifference only regarding the continuous work of EURALO and ALAC. Please note that there are some **minimum criteria** for an ALS and its participation at the RALO work – more details you can find here:

Therefore we offer you a last chance to respond to this message by outlining HOW you may contribute to EURALO in future until Saturday, 31 May 2014, midnight.

Otherwise we will immediately ask ALAC for your decertification in June.

Hello Heike,

your organisation – Terre des Femmes – was certified (under No. 50) in February 2006 as an At-Large structure (ALS) at EURALO. As you know, EURALO was created by signing a MoU with ICANN in March 2007 and became operational soon afterwards. Since then we had subsequent General Assemblies from 2008 (3 face-to-face when all members were invited and 3 with remote participation).

Since your certification in early 2006 your ALS participated at two GAs (Paris 2008 and Mexico-City 2009) incl. the 1st At-Large Summit. After that you / your ALS was involved in our regional consultation on ALAC Board seat 15 in autumn 2010 – what was your over and out. Some time later I realized that you were unsubscribed from the EURALO list while not suggesting any further contact point for your ALS.

After almost four years, we can take these facts as a clear message of indifference only regarding the continuous work of EURALO and ALAC. Please note that there are some **minimum criteria** for an ALS and its participation at the RALO work – more details you can find here:

Hi Théo,

your organisation – Yinternet.org – was certified (under No. 43) in February 2006 as an At-Large structure (ALS) at EURALO. As you know, EURALO was created by signing a MoU with ICANN in March 2007 and became operational soon afterwards. Since then we had subsequent General Assemblies from 2008 (3 face-to-face when all members were invited and 3 with remote participation).

Since your certification in early 2006 your ALS participated at one GA (Paris 2008) and nothing after any more. You were invited to two F2F GAs (Mexico-City 2009 and Lisbon 2013) incl. two At-Large Summits (2009 and 2014). I realized that you mandated two subsequent collaborators for serving as contact points who never followed up with us (GAs, regional consultations on ALAC Board seat 15 or whatsoever). And when they stopped working for you, you didn't assign a further contact point for your ALS. Moreover, I directly contacted you several times asking about your EURALO involvement without any feedback ever.

After almost five years, we can take these facts as a clear message of indifference only regarding the continuous work of EURALO and ALAC. Please note that there are some **minimum criteria** for an ALS and its participation at the RALO work – more details you can find here:

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Otherwise we will immediately ask ALAC for your decertification in June.

As you know, EURALO was created by signing a MoU with ICANN in March 2007 and became operational soon afterwards. Since then we had subsequent General Assemblies from 2008 (3 face-to-face when all members were invited and 3 with remote participation).

Since your certification in summer 2007, your ALS participated in two GAs (Paris 2008 and Mexico-City 2009) incl. the 1st At-Large Summit. After that you / your ALS was still involved in our regional consultation on ALAC Board seat 15 in autumn 2010 followed by continuous silence from your side. And no responses to further invitations (Lisbon F2F GA 2013, next GA and ATLAS II etc.) and even on direct reminders any more.
