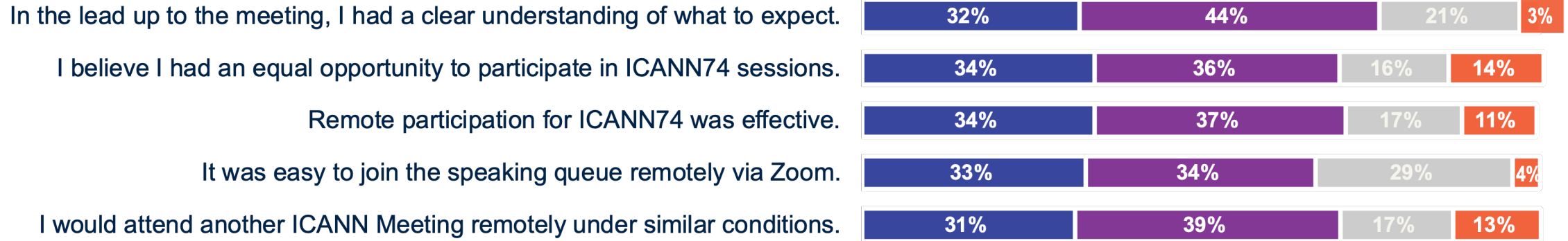

---

- Improve communications related to use of headphones and interpretation services.

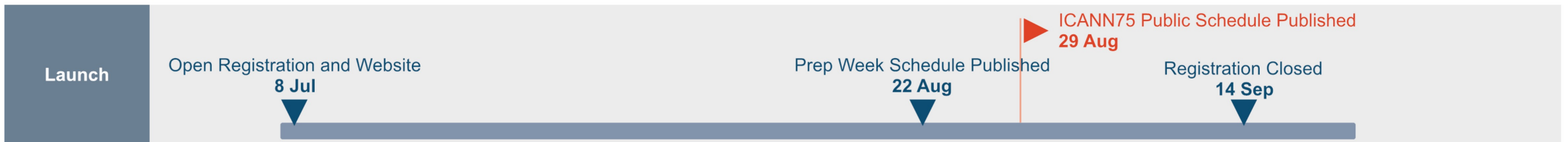
