



We thank our EURALO members for EuroDIG summaries:

Emilia Zalewska-Czajczyńska Senior Specialist for Strategic Analysis in Cybersecurity EURALO member, ALAC member:

This year, EuroDIG 2024 was an opportunity to discuss topics such as European policies and strategies related to human rights, cyber resilience and messenger interoperability, GovTech and AI. For me it has been a busy time – I took an active role in 2 sessions.

In the first one, panel 'One for all, all for one: the role of cooperation in enhancing cyber resilience in Europe' I was a Focal Point and a moderator. It featured Jacek Oko (Office of Electronic Communications), Nataliya Tkachuk (National Security and Defence Council of Ukraine), Matthias Hudobnik (ICANN, Security and Stability Advisory Committee) and Dina Lurje (Nord Security) as panelists. We discussed various aspects of cooperation on crosssectoral and cross-border level, including examples of best practices and relevant legislation. Some speakers highlighted the need for efficient implementation of regulations to achieve an appropriate level of regulatory harmonisation in EU Member States. Another key topic mentioned by panelists and audience was importance of cooperation in times of war and for effective cybercrime tackling

. Part of the discussion was also dedicated to the role of standards and accessibility of cybersecurity measures and training for people with different needs.

Together with my colleague from NASK PIB, Piotr Słowiński, we organised also a second session entitled "Digital skills for the jobs of today and tomorrow - join the debate". As part of it, with expert Wout de Natris (Dynamic Coalition IS3C), we invited the audience to discuss how to prepare young people for the demands of today's job market in cybersecurity and how higher education systems can be adapted to better meet today's realities. The topic resonated with the audience – several participants shared their comments and own examples of experiences. We take it as a sign that it is worth continuing the debate on this topic in the future.

A lot of other interesting discussions happened at EuroDIG. One that particularly caught my attention was related to the opportunities and risks connected with detecting harmful or illegal content, such as CSAM (Children Sexual Abuse Material) using AI. Even though, after all, I still believe there are more questions than answers in this area, it was a good opportunity to listen to different, sometimes opposite, points of view.

I was also very pleased to have had the opportunity to meet and chat with so many EURALO/ICANN/RIPE NCC people. These interactions were definitely one of the biggest highlights of my participation in the event

The European Dialogue on Internet Governance (EuroDIG) 2024, themed "Balancing Innovation and Regulation," took place from June 17-19 in Vilnius, Lithuania. Hosted by the Communications Regulatory Authority of Lithuania (RRT), this year's EuroDIG joined forces with the Baltic Domain Days 2024, which took place at the same location and time, creating a comprehensive platform for discussions on internet governance and related topics.

EURALO was represented by a few members who actively participated in the event's discussions and sessions. Their contributions highlighted the importance of multistakeholder engagement and the need for balanced approaches to internet governance.

Natálie Terčová spoke at the NRI Assembly, addressing key issues in three segments: establishing new National and Regional IGFs, engaging governments, and discussing the role and future of NRIs in the IGF ecosystem. Reflecting on her experience as the IGF Czechia Chair, Natálie remarked: *"Engaging with fellow NRI leaders was incredibly insightful as we shared common challenges and strategies for overcoming them. I deeply appreciate the EuroDIG organizers for providing us with the platform to emphasize the critical role of IGFs in the broader internet governance dialogue."*

Emilia Zalewska-Czajczyńska played a pivotal role as a focal point, coordinating the session titled "One for all, all for one: the role of cooperation in enhancing cyber resilience in Europe." This session emphasized the critical need for cooperation to bolster cyber resilience across Europe.
